HEMORRHOID TREATMENT INSTRUCTIONS	
DIET CHANGES	<ul> <li>AFTER MIDNIGHT: STOP EATING</li> <li>You can consume CLEAR LIQUIDS up until 3 hours before the test         <ul> <li>Clear liquids include iced/hot tea, black coffee, clear broth, apple or white grape juice (without pulp), gingerale, jello, ice pops</li> </ul> </li> <li>3 HOURS BEFORE TEST:         <ul> <li>STOP CLEAR LIQUIDS; No candy or gum chewing either</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
MEDICATIONS	<ul> <li>If you are taking Medicines That Thin Your Blood: Contact your provider to discuss any adjustments that might be required         <ul> <li>Medications include but are not limited to Aspirin, Plavix, Coumadin, Lovenox, Eliquis, Xarelto</li> </ul> </li> <li>If you are taking Aspirin: Do not hold it. Please take it the morning of your procedure with a small sip of water.</li> <li>If you are taking Blood Pressure Medication: Do not hold them. Take them the morning of your procedure with a small sip of water.</li> <li>If you are taking Diabetes Medications: Contact your prescribing doctor to discuss adjustments the day before and the day of your procedure</li> </ul>
BOWEL PREPARATION	<ul> <li>PURCHASE: TWO FLEET ENEMAS at any drug store (over the counter)</li> <li>TWO HOURS BEFORE TEST:         <ul> <li>Use the FIRST ENEMA following package directions</li> </ul> </li> <li>ONE AND A HALF HOURS BEFORE TEST:         <ul> <li>Use the SECOND ENEMA following package directions</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
OFFICE ARRIVAL	<ul> <li>Take your regular medications in the morning with sips of water</li> <li>Arrive 30 minutes prior to your procedure, no later!</li> <li>Bring list of current medications including doses</li> <li>Bring a Photo ID</li> <li>Bring Insurance Card</li> <li>Bring any applicable Referrals</li> <li>Please do not bring any valuable</li> </ul>
ESCORT	<ul> <li>Please ensure that you have an escort (responsible adult over the age of 18) to pick you up at the end of the procedure</li> </ul>
URINE PREGNANCY TESTING	If you are a premenopausal woman, you will need to submit a urine sample upon office check in
